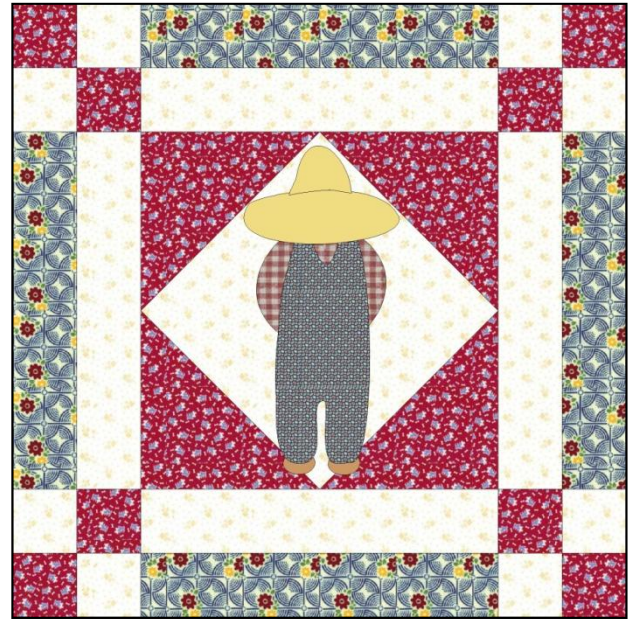


Sunbonnet Sue and Overall Bill

Cutting Instructions for the Sunbonnet Sue block:

Background fabric: white print— Cut one 5 ½ inch square.

Cut four 7½" x 1¾" strips.

Cut two more 7 ½" strips, then sub cut into eight 1¾" rectangles.

Dark green print: Cut four 7½" x 1¾" strips.

Multi-colored print: Cut two 4 ⅜ inch squares, then cut each square once on the diagonal.

Cut eight 1¾ inch squares.

Appliqué pieces: ***if you want Sue and Bill to face the way they do in the picture, and you are doing fusible appliqué like we did, you will need to reverse the patterns.

Lavender solid—bonnet

Green Floral—apron, hat band

Peach—arm

Brown—shoe

Purple Floral—dress, sleeve

Cutting Instructions for the Overall Bill block:

Background fabric: white print— Cut one 5 ½ inch square.

Cut four 7½" x 1¾" strips.

Cut two more 7 ½" strips, then sub cut into eight 1¾" rectangles.

Medium blue floral print: Cut four 7½" x 1¾" strips.

Red print: Cut two 4 ⅜ inch squares, then cut each square once on the diagonal.

Cut eight 1¾ inch squares.

Appliqué pieces: ***if you want Sue and Bill to face the way they do in the picture, and you are doing fusible appliqué like we did, you will need to reverse the patterns.

Blue Strip—overalls (stripes should be vertical)

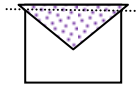
Red Check—shirt

Brown—shoe

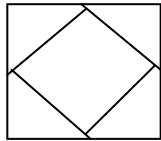
Gold floral—hat

Sunbonnet Sue and Overall Bill Background Blocks:

Sew each of the triangles to a side of the white print square as shown below.



Sew together as the picture shows to make the $7\frac{1}{2}$ inch center. Your square in a square should measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches and be sure that there is a $\frac{1}{4}$ seam allowance around the white center square as shown on the diagram.

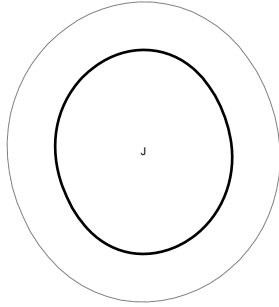
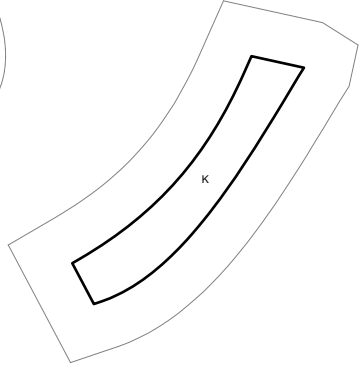
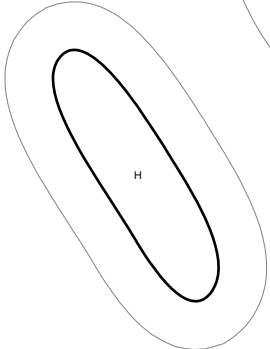
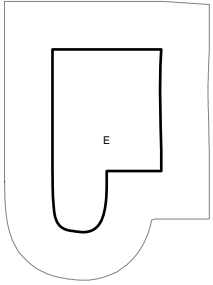
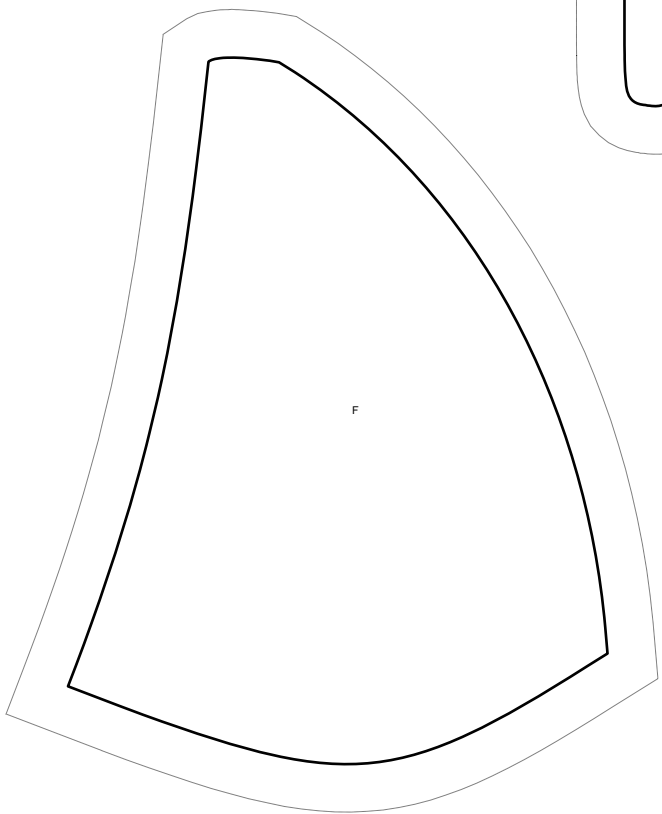
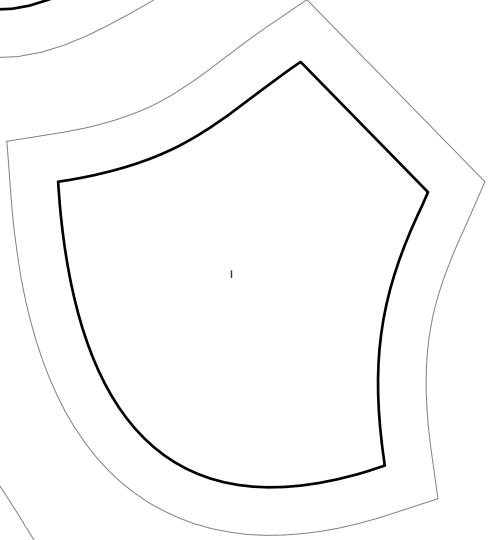
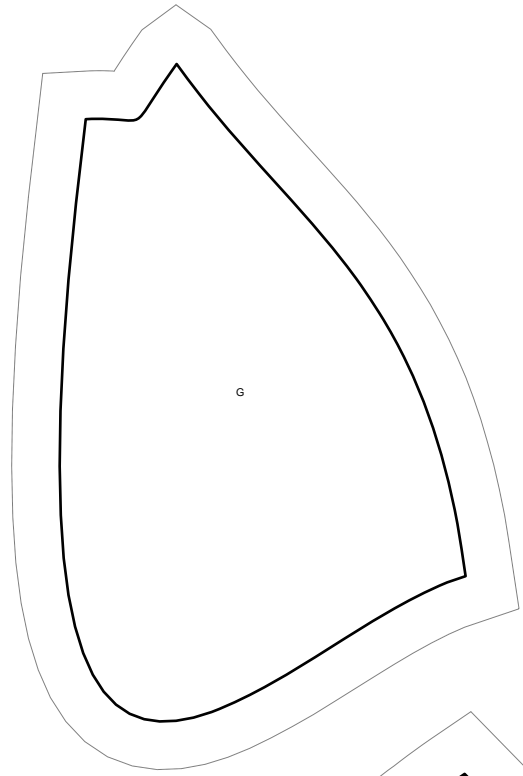
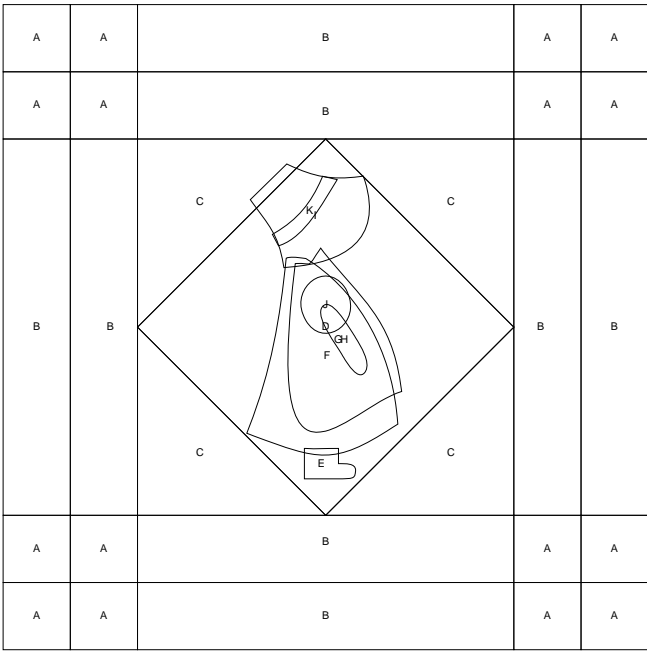


Piece together the rest of your background block using the picture as a color and piecing guide.
Press and square your block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches square.

Appliqué Sue and Bill using the picture as a guide—but—feel free to adjust your pieces to please yourself.
We used a little fusible web to tack down our figures and then stitched around them to secure and outline with medium brown thread.
