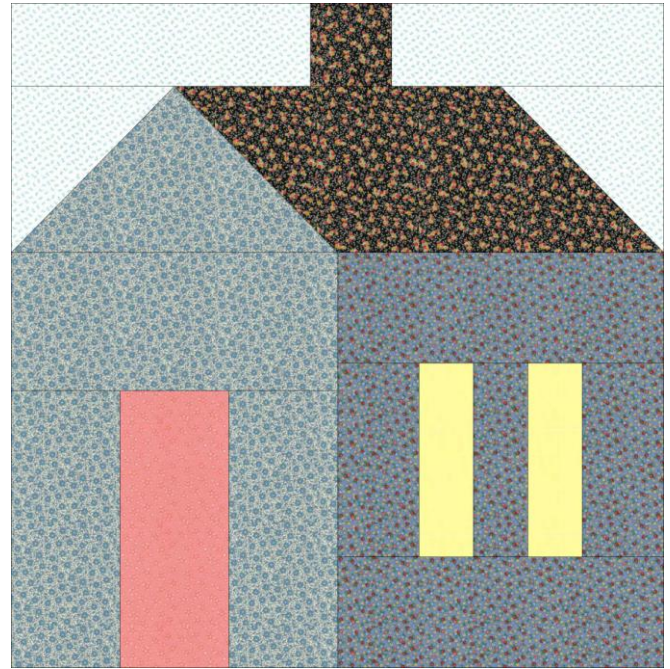
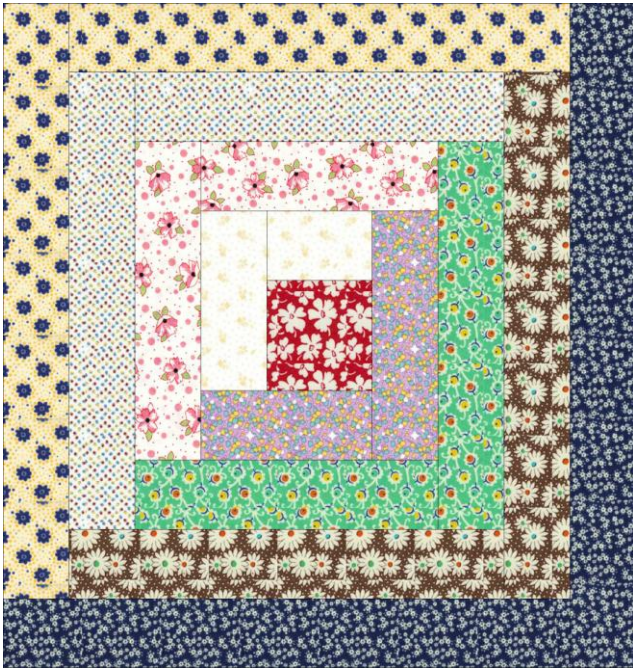

Thirties Fabrics Free Pattern Number 6

A Log Cabin & A House



Cutting Instructions for the Log Cabin Block:

Red print: Cut a 2½ x 2½ inch square

Cut **two** "log" strips 1¾ inches wide from the rest of your fabrics. The length measurements are as follows:

Dark Blue: 12 ½ and 11 ¼ inches long

Brown: 10 and 8 ¾ inches long

Green: 7 ½ and 6 ¼ inches long

Lavender: 5 and 3 ¾ inches long

Yellow: 11 ¼ and 10 inches long

White with multi colored print: 8 ¾ and 7 ½ inches long

Pink floral: 6 ¼ and 5 inches long

White with yellow flowers: 3 ¾ and 2 ½ inches long

Follow the color diagram above and begin sewing with the red center square and the shortest white (with yellow flowers) strip. Press toward the red square and then continue with the second strip of the same color. You will work your way around the red center counterclockwise beginning each new color with the shortest strip. Remember to press after each strip is added. Press the block and square to 12 ½ inches.

Cutting Instructions for the House Block:

White background print: Cut two 5 ¾ inch x 2 inch rectangles

Cut one 3 7/8 inch square and cut once on the diagonal

Lighter Blue Print: Cut one 6 ½ x 3 inch – above the door. Cut two 5 ½ x 2 ½ - both sides of the door

Cut one 7 ¼ inch square, cut on both diagonals –use one of these patches for the gable

Darker Blue Print: Cut two 6 ½ x 2 ½ inch pieces (above and below windows)

Cut two 4 x 2 inch pieces and one 4 x 1½ inch piece (narrower piece goes between windows)

Black Print: Cut one 2 inch square for chimney

Cut one piece 3 ½ by 10 ¼ (not 10 ½) inches for roof.

Yellow: Cut two 4 x 1½ inch pieces for windows

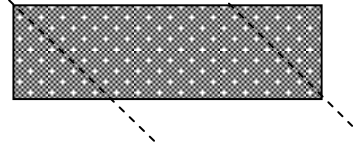
Pink print: Cut one 5 ½ x 2 ½ inch piece for the door

Constructing the House Block:

Sew the two background rectangles to either side of the chimney

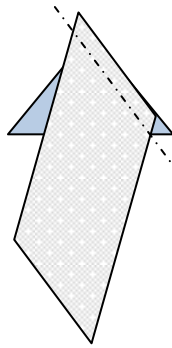
Roof:

Place the 45 degree line of your ruler on the bottom edge of the roof piece and trim as shown:



Sew the house gable (lighter blue) to the left side of the roof-right sides together.

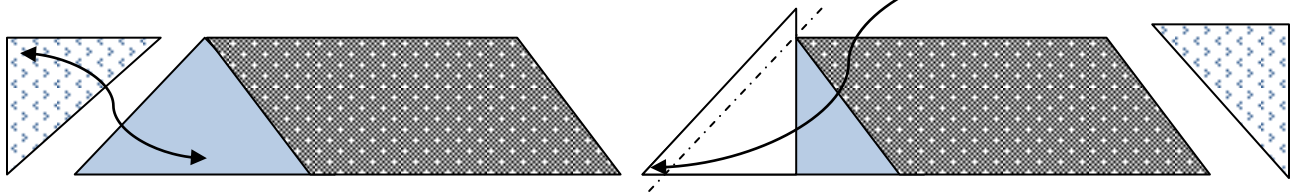
Be sure to have your "bunny ears" equal before you start to sew.



Follow the diagram below to add the background to the roof/gable section.

When you add the background triangles to the roof/gable section, put right sides together,

line up the bottom edge & outer tips where this arrow shows
sew along the dotted line. Repeat for the right side of the roof.



Make the front of the house section by sewing a light blue piece to either side of the pink door. Sew the 6 ½ piece by 3 inch lighter blue piece to this section using the picture as a guide.

Make the side of the house by sewing the windows and darker blue pieces together as the diagram shows with the narrower blue piece between the windows. Sew the top and bottom pieces above and below the windows.

Sew the front of the house section to the side of the house section. Add the roof "row". Add the chimney "row".

Press and square to 12 ½ inches.
